Respectful Behavior

SCP volunteers are a representative of the organization's brand and image and are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner and support the mission, goals and efforts of SCP with a positive, cooperative attitude. Please be polite, courteous, helpful and tolerant when dealing with the public, customers, fellow volunteers, veterinarians/kennels and their office staff and adoption venue or outside events management and staff. This expectation applies to online and/or written material, as well as personal interaction with the public and other volunteers.

Confidentiality

Any information pertaining to SCP and its records including contact information for volunteers, fosters and customers is considered privileged and confidential. Volunteers are responsible for maintaining confidentiality of all privileged information while serving as a volunteer for SCP. Volunteers are prohibited from discussing with the media any information found in the records of SCP, unless written authorization has been given by the Board of Directors. If contacted or approached by the media or someone requesting such information, volunteers should direct that person to the Board of Directors via the Board-specific email address (2ndchancepetsboard@gmail.com)
