Our Mission: SCP is a foster care organization focused on animal advocacy through responsible rescue, rehabilitation and appropriate placement of cats and dogs.

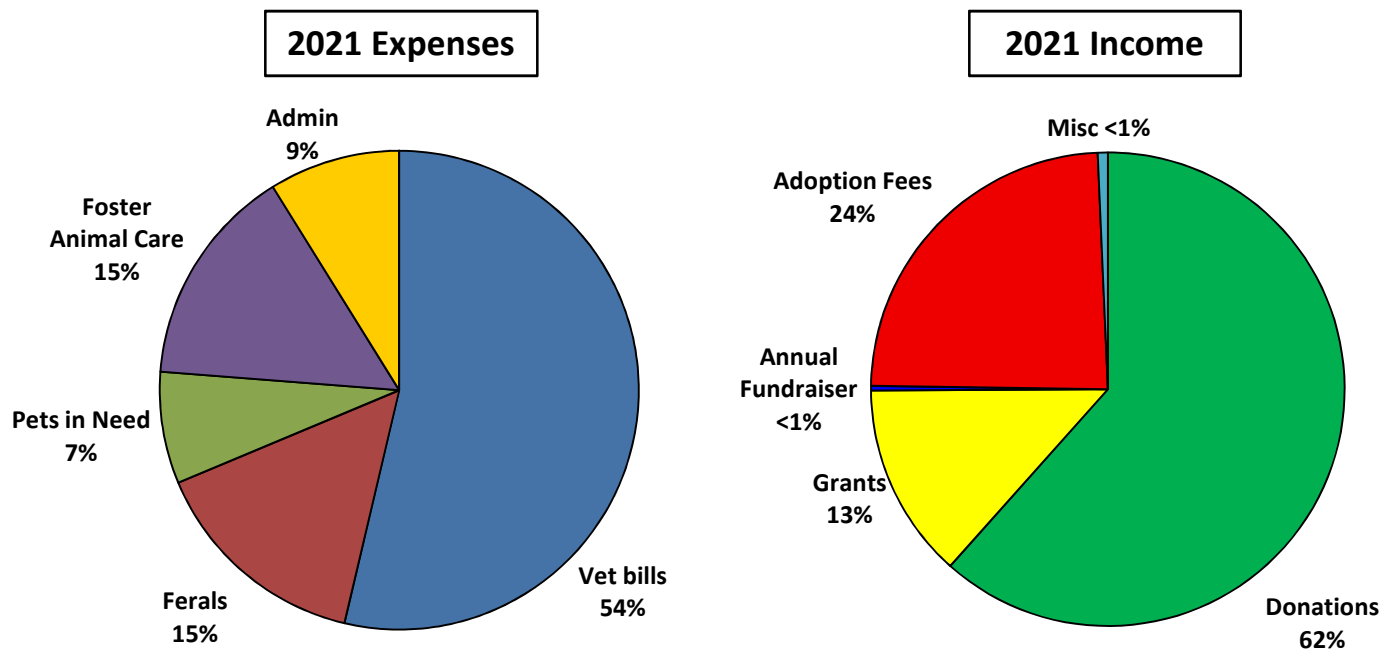
Our Vision: Save more lives, reduce the number of local homeless animals, seek and support lifelong homes for our adopted animals, reduce over-population through spay and neuter, animal advocacy through education.

2021 Accomplishments:

- Found forever homes for 234 pets in our foster care program (127 cats and 107 dogs) despite the pandemic
- Rescued multiple new animals with special medical needs (surgery, heartworm treatment, dental, skin issues)
- Sponsored sterilization surgery for 269 feral/community cats
- Covered \$4,301 in pet medical bills for pet owners in financial need (WOOFF/Compassion Fund)
- Provided \$5,088 in community program support (anesthesia machine for GESP) and shelter pet medical care

2021 Financial Summary:

91% of our income went directly to animal care. We had no fundraising expense as our annual fundraiser was unfortunately cancelled due to COVID 19. No donations, grants or adoption fees are ever used for fundraising.



2021 fundraising activities and events included:

- Donations from individual supporters, a number of which included matching gifts from employers
- Annual fundraiser was cancelled due to COVID, although we had a small profit selling some leftover items
- Grants from: Petco Love (\$6,500), Houston PetSet (\$7,500) and Petfinder Foundation (\$1,000)
- Retailer donation programs including Petco, Kroger, Randalls, Amazon Smile and others (\$3,779)
- Facebook online fundraisers (\$11,190)
- Bluebonnet fundraiser by volunteer (\$1,043)
